On the programme

- **A horse-drawn carriage ride in the heart of the Presidential Estate:** discover this 800 ha secret oasis, formerly the stage for royal, imperial then presidential hunts, and today an exceptional site with its varied landscape, ecological riches, preserved fauna and flora, etc. (Saturday or Sunday afternoon)



- **A tour of the Château of Rambouillet:** set in the middle of 20,000 hectares of forest, this former residence of the Kings of France has kept its fortified outer wall and its 14th-century Keep.

- **A tour of the Bergerie Nationale (National Sheep farm):** a real working farm built under Louis XVI, dominated by its sheepfolds where over 1000 lambs are born each year, including the famous merinos.
